

PERU MISSION ITINERARY

Starting in Cusco on April 21st 2010



- Day 1: Welcome dinner at typical restaurant in Cuzco.
- Day 2: Morning departure by private bus for lunch in Chacabamba and afternoon delivery of school supplies and food in Quisicancha. Night and dinner in hostel in Chacabamba.
- Day 3: Visit to secondary school in Chacabamba and delivery of donations to the school and community. Activities with the community during the remainder of the day.
- Day 4: Early departure for Quisicancha - building and installing high efficiency stoves. Late afternoon return to Cuzco.

You can also support our mission without participating in the trip:

By making a donation and indicating in the memo field of your check that it should be applied to humanitarian aid for the mission to Peru. The Cusco area has recently suffered severe flooding and mudslides that have left families homeless and wiped out all crops. We hope to provide food to the families of Quisicancha and Chacabamba.

\$290.00 Fee includes:

- Welcome dinner
- Transportation to Chacabamba, Quisicancha, and back to Cuzco in a comfortable private bus.
- Two nights at basic hostel with bunk beds in Chacabamba
- All meals while in Chacabamba and Quisicancha
- All tips to drivers and hostel staff.

The hotel where we are staying, when in Cuzco, offers double rooms at \$40.00 and a single at \$35.00. We will make your reservation, but you will pay the hotel during your stay. You are free to book your own reservation at a more or less expensive hotel of your choice and join the team at the restaurant for the welcome dinner and at our hotel for the departure to Chacabamba.

This mission unfolds at high altitude in the Andes (11,000 ft). It gets cold at night and the accommodations in Chacabamba are very Spartan, but clean. You will go for two days without showers unless you enjoy an icy cold one. Meals are good and plentiful and the experience is unique.



To reserve a place on this mission:

Please send your non refundable check in the amount of \$20.00 made to Global Legacy Programs. The balance of \$270.00 should be received by GLP by March 21st, 2010 or your reservation will be canceled in favor of someone on our waiting list. Your \$270.00 fee and donation cannot be reimbursed after the March 21st deadline as the funds will have been sent to Caritas Cuzco for the purchase of aid we shall distribute and preparations for our visit.

We are planning to offer the communities aid that will be locally purchased and prepared for us in advance. Your donation of \$100.00 will be applied towards the purchase of these items.

You are not required to purchase or collect any aid. Please contact us if you would like to organize a collection. We can advise you on what is most needed and easiest to carry. Remember that any item you bring should be in sufficient quantities to be offered to all children or families.

Some of you have expressed concerns about the train to Machu Picchu not returning to service by April 21st. The government announced on February 7th that the rail service will resume in three weeks. Of course, we cannot count on that and I fully understand that it is a long way to Peru and, for some of you, it is important to combine a visit to the archeological site with the mission.

Should there be no train service to Machu Picchu, by March 31st you will be given the option to join the next trip, in July, or get a refund of \$270.00. The \$20.00 registration fee will not be refunded.
