SAMPLE ITINERARY



Day one: Welcome dinner at typical restaurant in Cuzco.

Day two: Morning departure by private bus for aid delivery in Quisicancha. Night and dinner in hostel in Chacabamba.

Day three: Visit to secondary school in Chacabamba and delivery of donations. Activities with the community.

Day four: Early departure for Quisicancha building and installing high efficiency stoves. Late afternoon return to Cuzco.
